Sending crypto to the wrong network is a common yet avoidable mistake that often results in an irreversible loss. For bank transfers, delays may occur due to banking hours or local regulations. Check the transaction history inside Coinbase as well as the external blockchain explorer (for crypto) or your bank statement (for fiat). Sometimes funds are credited but not yet reflected in the app due to synchronization lags.

When self-help doesn’t solve the issue, contacting Coinbase Support becomes essential. Always use official channels through the Coinbase Help Center—never trust random phone numbers or social media accounts claiming to be support. Provide as many details as possible: timestamps, transaction IDs, screenshots, error messages, and the steps you already tried. The more complete your information, the faster support can diagnose

e the issue. Response times can vary, so patience and proper documentation are [+1>>843>>259>>2803](#) key.

Finally, prioritize account security throughout the process.
